To plan CPD with Charanga, and staff meetings to review the music coverage within the school and develop staff understanding and knowledge. To ensure staff plan lessons which help children to progress and learn musical vocabulary which is then shown within their work produced, by observing teaching and looking at evidence in floor books. To continue to build on the bank of instruments within school to support children's learning and musical experience.	For children to understand the relevance of what they are learning within music and to enjoy their musical experiences within school. To evidence children's work throughout school and ensure they experience performances from others as well as performing themselves. To continue to check music data and curriculum coverage to best support children's learning and progression as well as staff knowledge. To collect pupil interviews each year to ensure that their voice is heard in regards to the school's music curriculum and subject coverage.
